Day 9Jan 21** **Cape Horn, Chile – Cruising**

Today, we will cruise in Cape Horn, Chile from 6:00 AM to 8:00 AM.

Day 13Jan 25** **Port Stanley, Falkland Island**

This morning, we will arrive Port Stanley, Falkland Island. Ships disembark at 8:00 AM and embark at 5:00 PM.

Commune with the roughly 2,000 intrepid souls who call this remote former whaling outpost home. As you hike through the rocky, windswept landscape you may observe a few of the island's flightless residents—including Magellan penguins burrowing underground, and rockhoppers carefully observing you from outcroppings.

Day 14Jan 26** **At Sea – Cruising**

Today is a **Sea Day**. While at sea, take the time to recharge before the next adventure. Lounge by the pool, be spoiled at the spa, taste the delicacies or explore the venues on-board, until we arrive at the next amazing destination.

Day 15Jan 27** **Puerto Madryn, Argentina**

This morning, we will arrive Puerto Madryn, Argentina. Ships disembark at 7:00 AM and embark at 4:00 PM.

This deep water port was founded in 1865 by Welsh immigrants. Extending out into the Atlantic from Puerto Madryn is the Península Valdés, a wildlife sanctuary where vast numbers of sea elephants, whales and penguins far outnumber the few human visitors who make it out this far. We can explore the city on our own or join an optional tour (TBA).

Day 16Jan 28****At Sea – Cruising**

Today is a **Sea Day**. While at sea, take the time to recharge before the next adventure. Lounge by the pool, be spoiled at the spa, taste the delicacies or explore the venues on-board, until we arrive at the next amazing destination.

Day 17Jan 29****Montevideo, Uruguay**

This morning, we will arrive Montevideo, Uruguay. Ships disembark at 9:00 AM and embark at 4:00 PM. Montevideo is a thoroughly modern city with a rich artistic tradition, the reach of the rural estancias is all around you. We can explore the city on our own or join an optional tour (TBA).

Day 18Jan 30****Buenos Aires → Houston****(L)**

Today, we head back to **Buenos Aires** where our fantastic voyage comes to an end. We'll be docking at 5am, ending our fantastic journey to Antarctica. Our first stop of this day tour will be **9 de Julio Avenue**, the widest street in the city, it is possible to spot the **Obelisk**, the monument that symbolizes the city, and the famous **Colon Theatre (Opera House)**, a masterpiece of architecture with superb acoustics. Then on to **San Telmo** neighborhood, birthplace of the city, and to **May Square**, historical and political center, surrounded by the Government House or 'Casa Rosada', site of the national government; the Cabildo, historical building which was the center of the colonial political life; the **Metropolitan Cathedral** and the **Town Hall**, site of the city government. We proceed to **La Boca** district, a picturesque neighborhood where the Italian immigrants settled and the location of Caminito Street, famous because it inspired the tango "Carminito" by Juan de Dios Filiberto. Heading north, we enter the aristocratic **Recoleta** district, known for its **Cemetery** and visit Palermo, a wide and beautiful park located in the heart of one of the most elegant areas in the city. After our late lunch, we will transfer to Buenos Aires International Airport for our return flight to Honolulu via Houston and San Francisco.

Day 19Jan 31****Houston → San Francisco**

Upon arrive in Houston airport; we will continue our flight to San Francisco. Upon arrival at SFO, proceed to immigration and customs. We will take the shuttle bus to our hotel.

Day 20Feb 1****San Francisco → Honolulu**

We will take a flight back to Honolulu, taking with us the lasting memories of this wonderful Cruise to Antarctica.
