Day 1 Honolulu → Tokyo

We start our adventure by boarding an international flight to **Tokyo**, the capital city of Japan, and one of the most populous metropolitan areas in the world. Meals and snacks will be served on the plane.

Day 2 Tokyo

Upon arrival at Tokyo Haneda International Airport, an Air & Sea Travel representative will greet us and escort us to our hotel in Tokyo Disney Resort Partner Hotel.

Day 3 Tokyo (B)

Today, we'll immerse ourselves in the magic of **Tokyo DisneySea**, where we can rediscover our inner child in Mickey Mouse's enchanting hometown. As the fourth most visited theme park in the world, it offers a delightful experience for children of all ages. Inspired by ocean tales and legends, Tokyo DisneySea features seven themed ports, each brimming with imaginative attractions and entertainment. Key highlights include Mermaid Lagoon, American Waterfront, Port Discovery, Mysterious Island, and Mediterranean Harbor. We can take the hotel shuttle or the Disney Resort Line to reach DisneySea. Once there, we can enjoy all the park has to offer for as long as we like!

Day 4 Tokyo (B)

Today, we'll dive into the enchanting world of **Tokyo Disneyland**, where fairy tales come to life! As one of the most magical theme parks in the world, it offers a delightful experience for guests of all ages. Tokyo Disneyland features classic attractions like Space Mountain, Pirates of the Caribbean, and It's a Small World, alongside unique offerings like the Star Tours adventure. The park is beautifully themed with lush gardens and iconic castles, providing the perfect backdrop for character meet-and-greets and live entertainment. We can explore themed lands such as Fantasyland, Tomorrowland, and Adventureland, each brimming with attractions, dining options, and shopping experiences. Make sure to check the latest schedule for parades and shows to fully enjoy the magical atmosphere. We can take the hotel shuttle or the Disney Resort Line to reach DisneySea. Let's create unforgettable memories at Tokyo Disneyland!

Day 5 Tokyo – Hakone – Lake Kawaguchi  (B, L, D)

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Hakone**, a picturesque mountainous town famous for its hot spring resorts and stunning views of the iconic Mount Fuji. Our first stop will be the **Hakone Shrine**, a national shrine nestled at the foot of Mount Hakone along the shores of Lake Ashi. The shrine's buildings are hidden within a dense forest and can be easily recognized by its impressive torii gates—one standing prominently in the lake and two others over the main street of Moto-Hakone. Next, we will embark on a **Sightseeing Cruise on Lake Ashi** aboard a medieval-style sailing vessel, where we can enjoy breathtaking views of Mount Fuji. Following the cruise, we'll take the popular **Hakone Ropeway**, which rises above Owakudani. As we travel from Sounzan to Owakudani, we'll have the opportunity to see the valley below and, on our way to Togendai, enjoy panoramic views of both Mount Fuji and Lake Ashi. After a full day of sightseeing, we will head to our Natural Hotel Spring Ryokan in **Lake Kawaguchi**, where we can relax and unwind for the evening.

Day 6 Lake Kawaguchi – Yokohama – Tokyo (B)

After breakfast, we will start our adventure by visiting **Yokohama**, the second-largest populated city in Japan after Tokyo and the most populous municipality of Japan. First, we will visit **The Cup Noodles Museum**. It is a fun and interactive museum in the Minato Mirai District that shows the history of instant ramen noodles using a combination of whimsical exhibits and hands-on workshops. In the **My Chicken Ramen Workshop** we can make our own instant ramen noodles from scratch, package them, and take them home to eat. **Yokohama Chinatown** is Japan's largest Chinatown, located in central Yokohama. A large number of Chinese stores and restaurants can be found in the narrow and colorful streets of Chinatown. We can enjoy some shopping and our

own lunch in Chinatown. After that, we will transfer back to **Tokyo** and check in to our hotel. You'll have the rest of the day to enjoy at your leisure, exploring the vibrant city, shopping, or indulging in delicious local cuisine on your own.

Day 7 **Tokyo** **(B, D)**

"Food samples", were born in the early Showa period. They are familiar at restaurants and other stores and unique to Japan. It can be said it is a culture of Japanese with dexterous hands. Today, we can experience **producing a food sample, fruit parfait**. Then, we will visit **Tsukiji Market**, the largest wholesale market for fresh fish, fruits, and vegetables in central Tokyo. Over ten warehouses serve as distribution centers for food products. Handling 2000 tons of marine products every day, it has become one of the world's largest fish markets. We can enjoy our own lunch here. This afternoon, we will have a visit to **Ueno Zoological Gardens**, the oldest zoo in Japan. It is the home to over 3,000 animals from 400 different species. One of the reasons why we visit here today is to see the giant panda. Then, we will walk to **Ueno Park**, a great place to spot the beautiful cherry blossoms. We will return to our hotel after dinner.

Day 8 **Tokyo** **(B)**

Full day at leisure. "Shop till you drop; eat till you overflow!" Enjoy this free day to shop around the city and eat whatever looks interesting.

Day 9 **Tokyo → Honolulu** **(B)**

After checking out of the hotel, we will go to **Senso-ji**, an ancient Buddhist temple. It is Tokyo's oldest and one of its most significant temples. The temple is dedicated to the bodhisattva Kannon (Avalokitesvara). Dominating the entrance to the temple is the **Kaminarimon** or "**Thunder Gate**". This imposing Buddhist structure features a massive paper lantern dramatically painted in vivid red-and-black tones to suggest thunderclouds and lightning. Beyond the Kaminarimon is **Nakamise-dori** with its shops, followed by the Hōzōmon or "Treasure House Gate" which provides the entrance to the inner complex. Within the precincts stand **A Stately Five-story Pagoda and the Main Hall**, devoted to Kannon Bosatsu. Catering to the visiting crowds, the surrounding area has many traditional shops and eating places that feature traditional dishes (hand-made noodles, sushi, tempura, etc.). These shops themselves are part of a living tradition of selling things to pilgrims who walked to Senso-ji. We can enjoy our own lunch here. After that, we will go to **Tokyo Skytree** is a broadcasting, restaurant, and **observation tower** in Tokyo and the tallest structure in Japan. In the afternoon, we will stop at **Costco** for last minutes shopping. After a long day, we will transfer to the Airport for our return flight to Honolulu, taking with us the lasting memories of this wonderful Japan trip.
