Day 1Mar 17** Honolulu → Haneda

Our vacation starts by boarding an international flight bound for **Beijing** via Haneda. Meals and snacks will be served on the plane.

Day 2Mar 18** Haneda → Beijing

Beijing, the huge capital of China and an ancient city of great splendor whose history goes back 3 millennia. Upon arrival, an Air and Sea Travel representative will greet us and take us to our hotel for check-in.

Day 3Mar 19** Beijing (B, D)

After breakfast, we will driver by **Tiananmen Square**, probably the largest and most magnificent public square in the world. We will then explore the **Forbidden City**, the largest and most well-preserved imperial palace and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This vast and exotic palace was brilliantly captured in the movie “The Last Emperor”. Seat of supreme power for over five centuries (1416-1911), the Forbidden City in Beijing, with its landscaped gardens and many buildings with nearly 10,000 rooms containing furniture and works of art, constitutes a priceless testimony to Chinese civilization during the Ming and Qing dynasties. Then, we will visit the **Temple of Heaven**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is widely regarded as the noblest example of religious architecture in all of China. This is where emperors came to worship heaven for a bountiful harvest. The design shows that heaven is high and the earth is low and reflects an ancient Chinese saying: 'The heaven is round and the earth is square'. The welcome Dinner features China’s famous Peking Ducks.

Day 4Mar 20** Beijing (B, L)

Today’s highlight is the fabled **Great Wall**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and a massive defensive structure built to keep intruders out. China has many things to see, but the one great wonder is the Great Wall. We can see it undulating for miles across the mountains. The scale of this wall must be seen to be believed—it is an awesome sight! After lunch, we will visit a **Jade Workshop**, where we will learn about Chinese jade culture. Then, we will return to our hotel and enjoy some shopping and our own dinner near the hotel.

Day 5Mar 21** Beijing → Shanghai (B, D)

After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport for our flight to Shanghai. **Shanghai** is the most populous city in China. Due to its rapid growth in the last two decades, it has again become a global city, exerting influence over finance, commerce, fashion, and culture. Upon arrival, we will enjoy our dinner before transfer to our hotel for check-in.

Hotel Accommodation – The Kunlun Hua Ting Hotel & Towers or similar

Day 6Mar 22** Shanghai (B, D)

After breakfast, we will visit **Lujiazui**, a locality in Shanghai that is a peninsula formed by a bend in the Huangpu River. Since the early 1990s, Lujiazui has been developed specifically as Shanghai's new financial district. Next, we will transfer to the **Bazaar or Open Market** at the **City God Temple**, where you can enjoy shopping for souvenirs or exploring the various food shops. We can enjoy our own lunch here. After lunch, we will explore the **Special Economic Zone of Pudong** and take a leisurely stroll along the east side of the Huangpu River. Here, you'll be treated to breathtaking views of the Bund and the bustling Pudong financial district. **The Bund** is a landmark of Shanghai, featuring many historical buildings that once housed government organizations. Today, these buildings are home to a variety of restaurants, bars, clubs, and boutiques. Finally, we will visit **Nanjing Road**, Shanghai's premier pedestrian shopping street. Stretching from the historic Bund to People's Square, Nanjing Road is famous for its massive array of international and local brands, historic department stores, vibrant nightlife, and diverse dining options. We will enjoy a dinner tonight before returning to our hotel.

Day 7Mar 23** Shanghai – Suzhou – Shanghai (B, L)

After breakfast, we will take a day trip to **Suzhou**. Suzhou has over 2,500 years of rich history, and relics of the past are abundant to this day. Upon arrival, we will visit the **Garden for Lingering In**. Then, we will take a **boat ride** to explore the **Grand Canal**, which is second only to the Great Wall as a Chinese ancient engineering feat. Because Suzhou is

famous for its delicate and smooth silk and embroidery, we've arranged for a visit to a **silk factory**. We will return to Shanghai and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 8Mar 24** **Shanghai** **(B)**

Today, we can enjoy our free day and explore the city of Shanghai.

Day 9Mar 25** **Shanghai → Kansai → Honolulu** **(B)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to Shanghai airport and fly back home via Kansai, taking with us lasting memories of this wonderful trip to China.
