Day 1Apr 3****Los Angeles → Paris → Madrid**

We start our vacation by boarding an international flight bound for **Madrid** via Paris. Madrid, the vibrant capital and largest city of Spain, welcomes us with its rich history, culture, and lively atmosphere. Meals and snacks will be served onboard the flight.

Day 2Apr 4****Madrid****(D)**

Upon arrival at **Madrid-Barajas International Airport**, an Air & Sea Travel representative will greet us and escort us to our hotel. Once checked in, we will have time to settle in and begin exploring Madrid. We will enjoy our dinner at the hotel tonight.

Day 3Apr 5****Madrid****(B, L, D)**

In the morning, we will visit one of Madrid's most renowned cultural treasures, the **Prado Museum**. Home to an exceptional collection of Spanish and European art, the museum features masterpieces spanning centuries and offers a fascinating glimpse into the development of European art. We will then enjoy a panoramic sightseeing tour of Madrid, including **Plaza Mayor**, the grand arcaded square in the heart of the city. Surrounded by elegant architecture, this historic plaza is a favorite gathering place for both locals and visitors. Next, we will continue to **Plaza de Espana**, a prominent landmark featuring the impressive Cervantes Monument and other notable statues. We will conclude our morning sightseeing with a visit to the magnificent **Royal Palace of Madrid**, the former residence of the Spanish royal family. Built in the 18th century in the Italian Baroque style, the palace stands on the site of an earlier Moorish fortress and is regarded as one of Europe's most beautiful and well-preserved royal residences. Tonight, **a traditional Flamenco dinner and show** is arranged. Enjoy music, dance, dinner and drinks.

Day 4Apr 6****Madrid – Torremocha de Jarama – Madrid****(B)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Torremocha de Jarama**, a charming town in the Madrid region, where we will visit **Fanum** for a guided **olive oil experience**. We will learn about the traditional production of Spanish olive oil, discover the process from harvest to bottling, and enjoy an olive oil tasting featuring the distinctive flavors and aromas of the region. We will then return to Madrid and visit the historic **Las Ventas Bullring**, one of Spain's most iconic bullfighting venues. We will learn about the traditions and history of bullfighting while admiring the impressive architecture of this renowned Madrid landmark. We will have the afternoon free to explore the city on our own and enjoy the rest of the day at our leisure.

Day 5Apr 7****Madrid – Segovia – Zaragoza****(B, L, D)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to the historic old town of **Segovia**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1985, renowned for its remarkable Roman Aqueduct and historic architecture. Our first stop will be the magnificent **Alcazar** of Segovia, a stunning stone castle shaped like the bow of a ship. Originally built as a fortress, the Alcazar has served various roles throughout its history, including a royal residence, prison, Royal Artillery College, and military academy. Its distinctive fairy-tale appearance is also said to have inspired Walt Disney's iconic Cinderella Castle. For lunch, we will enjoy one of Segovia's most famous specialties, traditional **Spanish roast suckling pig**. Afterward, we will admire the impressive **Roman Aqueduct**, one of Spain's most remarkable examples of ancient Roman engineering. Built to transport water into the city, this remarkably preserved structure stands as a testament to the ingenuity of Roman civilization. We will then continue to **Zaragoza**, an ancient city with more than 2,000 years of history. Located in the heart of northeastern Spain, Zaragoza offers a fascinating blend of historic heritage and diverse landscapes, ranging from forests and meadows to mountains and semi-arid terrain. The city also gained international attention as the host of Expo 2008. Upon arrival, we will check-in to our hotel and enjoy dinner at the hotel.

Day 6Apr 8****Zaragoza – Barcelona****(B, L, D)**

This morning, we will visit the magnificent **Basilica-Cathedral of Our Lady of the Pillar** in Zaragoza, a stunning Baroque-style Roman Catholic church and one of Spain's most important religious landmarks. The basilica is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary under the title of Our Lady of the Pillar, who is honored as the Mother of the Hispanic People. According to tradition, it is the first church in history dedicated to the Virgin

Mary. We will then continue to **Barcelona**, the capital of Catalonia and Spain's second-largest city. Renowned for its rich cultural heritage, striking architecture, and vibrant atmosphere, Barcelona is one of Europe's most popular destinations. The city is famous for Las Ramblas, historic neighborhoods, and its unique blend of traditional and modern influences, attracting visitors from around the world. Upon arrival, we will check in to our hotel and enjoy our dinner.

Day 7Apr 9**

After breakfast at our hotel, we will begin our Barcelona sightseeing with a visit to the magnificent **Sagrada Família**, Antoni Gaudí's iconic Roman Catholic basilica. Although the central Tower of Jesus Christ was completed in 2026, work continues on other elements of the basilica, including the Glory Façade. The Sagrada Família is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and features three grand façades: the Nativity Facade, the Passion Facade, and the Glory Facade. Next, we will continue to **Park Guell**, one of Gaudí's most celebrated creations. Designed between 1900 and 1914, the park showcases Gaudí's distinctive architectural style and is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site "**Works of Antoni Gaudi.**" We will then visit **Casa Mila**, also known as La Pedrera, the last major civil work designed by Gaudí. Built between 1906 and 1910, this remarkable building is renowned for its undulating stone façade, innovative design, and distinctive rooftop sculptures. It was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1984. Finally, we will pass by **Casa Batllo**, one of Gaudí's most imaginative masterpieces. Built in 1904 and famously known as the "Block of Discord," the building is celebrated for its colorful, organic forms and spectacular facade. It was recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005 and offers a wonderful photo opportunity during our time in Barcelona. Tonight, we can enjoy the rest of day on our own.

Day 8Apr 10**

Day 10Apr 12**

Tangier, Morocco

This morning, we will arrive Tangier, Morocco. Ships disembark at 7:00 AM and embark at 6:00 PM. Upon arrival at the pier, we will meet our English-speaking guide and begin our excursion to **Cap Spartel**, the spectacular coastal landmark where the Atlantic Ocean meets the Mediterranean Sea. We will enjoy the dramatic cliffside scenery and make a photo stop at the historic lighthouse. We will then visit the **Caves of Hercules**, an iconic sea cave known for its distinctive Africa-shaped opening. Then, we will explore the historic **Kasbah**, where we can experience Tangier's rich history and traditional Moroccan architecture. We will make a photo stop at **Kasbah Square**, which offers panoramic views of the ocean and the Strait of Gibraltar. We will then return to the Tangier pier in time for our cruise departure.

Day 11Apr 13**

Today is a **Sea Day**; we are on the way to Porto (Leixoes), Portugal.

Day 12Apr 14**

Porto (Leixoes), Portugal

This morning, we will arrive Porto (Leixoes), Portugal. Ships disembark at 8:00 AM and embark at 6:00 PM.

Upon arrival at the pier, we will meet our English-speaking guide and begin our full-day sightseeing tour of Porto, Portugal's vibrant second city and a UNESCO World Heritage destination. We will enjoy an **orientation city tour** featuring Porto's historic neighborhoods, beautiful architecture, and iconic landmarks. In the afternoon, we will embark on the **Douro River Six Bridges Cruise**. This relaxing cruise offers wonderful views of Porto and Vila Nova de Gaia while passing beneath the city's famous bridges and along the scenic

Douro River. We will then visit **Calem Wine Cellars** for an interactive experience that includes a guided tour of the museum and historic cellars. We will learn about the history and production of Port wine before enjoying a Classic wine tasting featuring white and red wines. After the tour, we will return to the pier for our cruise departure.

Day 13**Apr 15

Lisbon, Portugal

This morning, we will arrive Lisbon, Portugal. Ships disembark at 7:00 AM and embark at 5:00 PM.

Upon arrival at the pier, we will transfer to **Fatima**, a town in central Portugal and one of the country's most important religious destinations. The name "Fatima" is believed to have Moorish origins, reflecting the region's long and diverse history. Our first stop will be the **Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary of Fatima**, located within the Sanctuary of Fatima. At the entrance, we will admire a beautiful mosaic depicting the **Holy Trinity crowning the Virgin Mary**, created by artists under the direction of the Vatican. Inside the basilica, magnificent stained-glass windows portray scenes from the Marian apparitions, while the altars reflect the mysteries of the Rosary. We will then return to Lisbon for a **Lisbon City Tour**. Our sightseeing will begin with a photo stop at the iconic **25 de Abril Bridge**, spanning the Tagus River. Often compared to San Francisco's Golden Gate Bridge, this striking suspension bridge is one of Lisbon's most recognizable landmarks. Next, we will have the opportunity to view the impressive **Cristo-Rei (Christ the King) Statue**, a monumental Catholic statue overlooking Lisbon from across the Tagus River. The statue was built as an expression of gratitude that Portugal was spared the devastation of World War II. Then, we will return to the pier for our cruise departure.

Day 14**Apr 16

Seville (Cadiz), Spain

This morning, we will arrive Seville (Cadiz), Spain. Ships disembark at 11:00 AM and embark at 8:00 PM.

Upon arrival, we will begin our **orientation city tour** of Seville, one of Spain's most vibrant and historic cities. We will visit **Plaza de España**, also known as Spain Square, one of Seville's most iconic landmarks. Built for the Ibero-American Exposition of 1929, the grand plaza is famous for its beautiful architecture, tiled alcoves representing Spain's provinces, and picturesque canal. It has also appeared in several famous films, including Lawrence of Arabia and Star Wars. Next, we will visit the **Seville Cathedral and Giralda Tower**, one of the city's most important UNESCO World Heritage Sites. The magnificent cathedral is one of the largest Gothic churches in the world and is traditionally recognized as the burial place of Christopher Columbus. The adjoining Giralda Tower, or La Giralda, was originally constructed as the minaret of the Great Mosque of Seville and was later converted into the cathedral's bell tower. Those who climb the tower's 34 levels will be rewarded with spectacular panoramic views of Seville and the Guadalquivir River. After our sightseeing, we will return to the pier for our cruise departure.

Day 15**Apr 17

Malaga, Spain

This morning, we will arrive Malaga, Spain. Ships disembark at 8:00 AM and embark at 6:00 PM.

Enjoy an enhanced touring experience with greater interaction with our guide, a comfortable pace, and additional time to appreciate each destination. We will begin with a guided walking tour of **Malaga**, exploring the city's historic center and viewing the magnificent **Malaga Cathedral**, affectionately known as La Manquita, or "The One-Armed Lady." Next, we will explore the **Alcazaba**, an impressive hilltop Moorish fortress-palace built in the early 11th century. Overlooking the city and the Mediterranean Sea, the fortress offers a fascinating glimpse into Málaga's Moorish heritage, as well as spectacular views of the city, bay, and surrounding mountains. We will then enjoy a scenic drive through the area before continuing to **Mijas**, one of the Costa del Sol's most charming white villages. Known for its traditional Andalusian character, Mijas features narrow streets, whitewashed houses, colorful flowerpots, decorative ironwork, and bougainvillea and jasmine cascading over the walls. Upon arrival, we will have **free time to explore Mijas** at our own pace. Relax at one of the village's cafés, browse the local shops, or simply stroll through the picturesque streets and enjoy the beautiful views of the Mediterranean coastline.

Day 16Apr 18****At Sea**

Today is a **Sea Day**; we are on the way to Palma De Mallorca, Spain.

Day 17Apr 19****Palma De Mallorca, Spain**

This morning, we will arrive Palma De Mallorca, Spain. Ships disembark at 7:00 AM and embark at 5:00 PM.

Upon arrival at the pier, we will meet our English-speaking guide and begin our full-day excursion exploring Palma de Mallorca and Valldemossa. We will start with an orientation tour of Palma, Mallorca's vibrant capital, before visiting the magnificent **Palma Cathedral**. This impressive Gothic cathedral is one of the island's most iconic landmarks and is renowned for its soaring interior, beautiful stained glass, and spectacular waterfront setting. We will then travel to the picturesque mountain village of Valldemossa, nestled in the Tramuntana Mountains. Here, we will visit the historic **Cartuja Palace** (Royal Charterhouse of Valldemossa), including the Prior's Cell, the Palace of King Sancho, the church, pharmacy, and library. We will learn about the fascinating history of this former Carthusian monastery and its famous visitors. We will arrive back at the pier in time for our cruise departure.

Day 18Apr 20****Barcelona – Girona – Barcelona**

This morning, we will arrive back at **Barcelona Pier**, concluding our cruise. We will begin our day to **Girona**, a beautiful historic city in northeastern Catalonia known for its medieval architecture, charming old town, and fascinating Jewish heritage. We will enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of Girona, strolling through its picturesque historic center and discovering its narrow cobblestone streets, ancient walls, and beautifully preserved medieval buildings. We will then continue to **Barcelona**, where we will explore some of the city's most famous shopping and cultural areas. We will have free time to stroll along **La Rambla**, one of Barcelona's most iconic boulevards, and visit a local **souvenir shop**. Next, we will visit **Mercat de la Boqueria**, Barcelona's famous historic food market. Here, we can browse the colorful stalls offering fresh produce, local specialties, traditional Spanish foods, and other culinary delights. In the evening, we will enjoy our own dinner here before we check-in to our hotel.

Day 19Apr 21****Barcelona → Paris → Los Angeles**

After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport for the return flight to Los Angeles via Paris, taking home lasting memories of this magnificent trip to the Spain, Portugal and Morocco.
