Day 1May 28** **Los Angeles → Amsterdam → Prague**

Today, we will depart for **Prague**, the capital and largest city of the Czech Republic, known for its stunning historic architecture, charming cobblestone streets, and rich cultural heritage. We will travel via Amsterdam as our transit point. Overnight on board.

Day 2 May 29** **Prague** **(D)**

Prague blends centuries of history, magnificent architecture, and vibrant culture into one enchanting city. From the medieval charm of the Old Town and the iconic Charles Bridge to the majestic Prague Castle, every corner reveals a story from the past. The city's Gothic spires, Baroque buildings, picturesque squares, and winding cobblestone streets create an atmosphere unlike anywhere else in Europe. Upon arrival in Prague, an Air & Sea Travel representative will greet and escort us to our hotel. We will enjoy our dinner at the hotel tonight.

Day 3May 30** **Prague – Karlovy Vary – Prague** **(B, D)**

After breakfast, we will depart Prague for **Karlovy Vary**, one of the Czech Republic's most famous historic spa towns, renowned for its mineral springs, elegant colonnades, and picturesque setting. Upon arrival, we will enjoy an orientation tour featuring the viewing of **Mill Colonnade**, a beautiful Pseudo-Renaissance landmark housing several of the town's famous mineral springs, as well as the **Church of St. Peter and Paul**, known for its distinctive blue-and-gold domes. We will also stroll along **New Louka Street**, with its charming architecture and views of the Teplá River. We will then take a **funicular ride to the Diana Observation Tower**, offering spectacular panoramic views of Karlovy Vary and the surrounding countryside. Our tour continues with a visit to the **Hot Spring Colonnade**, home to Karlovy Vary's famous Vřídlo, a natural thermal spring and one of the city's most iconic attractions. After lunch on our own, we will visit the **Jan Becher Museum**, where we will learn about the history of Becherovka, the renowned Czech herbal liqueur, followed by a tasting. In the afternoon, we will return to **Prague** and enjoy an **orientation tour** of the city, introducing us to its historic neighborhoods and landmarks, followed by some free time. In the evening, we will board a **Vltava River dinner cruise** and enjoy a **buffet dinner**, welcome drink, and live music while taking in beautiful nighttime views of Prague's illuminated landmarks, including its historic bridges and riverside architecture.

Day 4May 31** **Prague** **(B)**

After breakfast at the hotel, we will begin our **full-day sightseeing tour of Prague**, a magnificent historic city whose Historic Centre of Prague is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Our morning will begin with a visit to **Prague Castle**, one of the city's most important landmarks and part of the UNESCO-listed Historic Centre of Prague. We will explore St. Vitus Cathedral, the magnificent Gothic cathedral and spiritual center of Prague; the Old Royal Palace, once the seat of Czech kings; St. George's Basilica, one of the oldest churches within the castle complex; and Golden Lane, a charming historic street of colorful small houses, including the medieval Daliborka Tower. We will continue our sightseeing with viewing of **Old Town Square**, the historic heart of Prague, where we will admire the famous **Astronomical Clock**. We will also see the iconic **Charles Bridge**, the elegant **National Theatre**, and the distinctive **Dancing House**. In the afternoon, we will enjoy **Afternoon Tea**, overlooking Old Town Square. Relax with a choice of coffee or tea accompanied by a delicious selection of cakes. The remainder of the afternoon will be at **leisure**, allowing time to explore Prague independently, browse local shops, or enjoy the atmosphere of the historic city center.

Day 5Jun 1** **Prague – Cesky Krumlov – Brno** **(B, D)**

After breakfast, we will depart travel to **Cesky Krumlov**. This beautifully preserved medieval town is one of the Czech Republic's most charming destinations and is recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its historic architecture and unique riverside setting. Upon arrival, we will explore the picturesque historic

center and enjoy views of the **Cesky Krumlov Castle Garden** and the **Church of St. Vitus**, a striking Gothic landmark overlooking the town. After our sightseeing, we will enjoy our own lunch at this beautiful city. In the afternoon, we will travel to **Brno**, the second-largest city in the Czech Republic and the historic capital of Moravia. Upon arrival, we will enjoy an orientation tour of Brno. We will see **Liberty Square**, the city's lively central square, as well as the **Moravian Museum** and **Bishop's Palace**, discovering some of the city's rich history and architectural heritage. After the tour, we will check in to our hotel and enjoy our dinner at the hotel.

Day 6** Jun 2	Brno – Vienna	(B, L, D)
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After breakfast, we will depart to **Vienna**, the elegant capital of Austria and a city renowned for its imperial history, magnificent architecture, classical music, and rich cultural heritage. Upon arrival, we will begin our sightseeing with a visit to **Schonbrunn Palace**, one of Vienna's most magnificent landmarks and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Once the summer residence of the Habsburg imperial family, the palace offers a fascinating glimpse into Austria's royal past. After our palace visit, we will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, including a traditional Viennese schnitzel. In the afternoon, we will continue with a guided Vienna city tour, passing some of the city's most important landmarks, including the **Jewish Quarter, Hofburg Palace, Parliament, and Vienna City Hall**. After sightseeing, we will check in to our hotel for dinner. In the evening, we will have the opportunity to attend a performance by the **Vienna Mozart Orchestra**, featuring the music of Mozart in an elegant concert setting. After the performance, we will return to the hotel.

Day 7** Jun 3	Vienna – Melk – Vienna	(B)
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After breakfast, we will travel to **Melk**, a charming town overlooking the Danube River and one of Austria's most picturesque historic destinations. Upon arrival, we will enjoy a **sightseeing tour** of Melk, discovering its historic character and beautiful surroundings. In the afternoon, we will return to **Vienna** and visit the famous **Spanish Riding School**, one of the city's most treasured traditions. We will enjoy a guided tour and learn about its centuries-old equestrian heritage and renowned Lipizzaner horses. We will then enjoy a fun and delicious **apple strudel-making class**, where we will discover how to prepare one of Austria's most beloved desserts. Tonight, the evening is ours to explore Vienna at our own pace, whether strolling through the historic city center, enjoying a cafe, or discovering Vienna's vibrant atmosphere.

Day 8** Jun 4	Vienna – Bratislava	(B, D)
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After breakfast, we will travel to **Bratislava**, the capital of Slovakia and a city located along the Danube River. Upon arrival, we will enjoy a sightseeing tour of Bratislava's historic center. We will visit **St. Martin's Cathedral**, one of the city's most important historic landmarks and the former coronation church of the Hungarian kings. We will also see the **Bratislava Castle**, dramatically situated on a hill overlooking the Danube, as well as the **Franciscan Church**, the **Jesuit Church**, and the **Bridge of the Slovak National Uprising**, one of the city's distinctive modern landmarks. After sightseeing, we will enjoy our own lunch, followed by **free time** to explore Bratislava at our own pace. Take a leisurely stroll through the Old Town, browse the local shops, or relax at one of the charming cafes. In the evening, we will experience an authentic Slovak cultural evening at the Folklore Garden Bratislava. Enjoy a dinner accompanied by beverages while experiencing a lively traditional Slovak folklore show, featuring music, dance, and local cultural traditions. After the evening's entertainment, we will return to the hotel.

Day 9** Jun 5	Bratislava – Sopron – Fertod – Gyor – Heviz	(B, D)
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After breakfast, we will travel to **Sopron**, a historic town in western Hungary known for its medieval character and well-preserved Old Town. Upon arrival, we will enjoy an orientation tour, including a photo stop at the **Firewatch Tower**, the town's most recognizable landmark. We will also see the historic **Main Square** and the **Kecske Temple**, one of Sopron's notable Gothic landmarks. We will then continue to **Fertod**, home to the magnificent **Esterhazy Palace**, one of Hungary's most impressive Baroque residences. The palace is

part of the UNESCO-listed Cultural Landscape and is often referred to as the "Hungarian Versailles." We will enjoy a visit of the palace and learn about the history and grandeur of the Esterházy family. Afterward, we will travel to **Gyor**, a historic Hungarian city situated at the meeting point of several rivers. Then, we will transfer to **Heviz**, famous for its natural thermal lake and long tradition as a spa destination. Upon arrival in Heviz, we will transfer to our spa hotel and enjoy a buffet dinner.

Day 10** Jun 6	Heviz – Szantod – Tihany – Badacsony – Heviz	(B, L, D)
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After breakfast, we will travel to **Szantod**, located on the southern shore of **Lake Balaton**, Central Europe's largest freshwater lake. The lake is one of Hungary's most popular holiday destinations, known for its scenic landscapes, charming lakeside towns, and vineyards. From Szantod, we will take a short **ferry across Lake Balaton to Tihany**, a picturesque peninsula famous for its beautiful natural surroundings and historic character. We will enjoy views of the lake during the crossing before continuing our journey. We will then travel to **Badacsony**, a scenic region on the northern shore of Lake Balaton, renowned for its volcanic hills, vineyards, and panoramic lake views. Here, we will enjoy a **wine tasting at Sipos Borhaz Winery**, followed by a lunch featuring local flavors. In the afternoon, we will return to **Heviz** and have some **free time** to relax and explore the town at our own pace. Heviz is famous for its natural thermal lake, one of Europe's largest biologically active thermal lakes and a popular wellness destination. In the evening, we will return to the hotel for a **buffet dinner** and enjoy the hotel's thermal and wellness facilities, providing a relaxing end to the day.

Day 11** Jun 7	Heviz – Budapest	(B, L, D)
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After breakfast, we will depart **Heviz** and travel to **Budapest**, the vibrant capital of Hungary, beautifully divided by the Danube River into historic Buda and lively Pest. After lunch, we will visit the famous **Szechenyi Thermal Bath**, one of Europe's largest and most impressive thermal bath complexes. Built in Neo-Baroque style and supplied by natural thermal springs, it offers a wonderful opportunity to relax in its indoor and outdoor pools. After enjoying the thermal baths, we will check in to our hotel in Budapest and enjoy a buffet dinner.

Day 12** Jun 8	Budapest – Esztergom – Visegrad – Szentendre – Budapest	(B, L)
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After breakfast, we will travel to **Esztergom**, one of Hungary's oldest cities and an important center of Hungarian history and Catholic heritage. Upon arrival, we will visit the magnificent **Esztergom Basilica**, Hungary's largest church and one of the country's most impressive landmarks. Perched high above the Danube, the basilica offers beautiful views toward Slovakia and the surrounding countryside. We will then continue to **Visegrad**, a historic town situated along the scenic Danube Bend. After an orientation tour, we will enjoy a unique **medieval-style lunch** at the Renaissance Restaurant, featuring traditional dishes, unlimited soft drinks, coffee or tea, and a lively **knights' tournament**. After lunch, we will visit **Visegrad Castle**, the impressive hilltop fortress offering spectacular views over the Danube Bend. The castle played an important role in medieval Hungarian history and was once a royal residence. We will then travel to **Szentendre**, a charming artistic town known for its colorful Baroque buildings, cobblestone streets, galleries, and riverside atmosphere. We will enjoy an orientation tour before visiting the **Szamos Marzipan Museum**, where we can admire intricate sculptures and creations made entirely from marzipan. In the late afternoon, we will return to **Budapest** and enjoy the rest of day on our own.

Day 13** Jun 9	Budapest	(B, L)
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After breakfast, we will enjoy a full-day sightseeing tour of **Budapest**, exploring the city's historic landmarks and experiencing the unique character of both Buda and Pest. We will begin with a drive along **Andrassy Avenue**, one of Budapest's most elegant boulevards, followed by views of **Heroes' Square**, a grand monument celebrating important figures from Hungarian history, and the magnificent **Hungarian State Opera House**. We will then visit the **Buda Castle Hill area**, part of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

Perched above the Danube, Buda Castle Hill offers beautiful views of the city and is home to historic streets, architecture, and landmarks. At **Fisherman's Bastion**, we will enjoy spectacular panoramic views across the Danube toward the Parliament Building and the Pest side of Budapest. Its distinctive towers and terraces make it one of the city's most memorable viewpoints. After lunch at a local restaurant, we will enjoy a **private cruise on the Danube River**. This relaxing cruise offers wonderful views of Budapest's iconic waterfront landmarks and bridges from the river. We will then have some free time to explore Budapest at our own pace and enjoy dinner on own.

Day 14 Jun 10 Budapest → Amsterdam → Los Angeles (B)**

Today, we will transfer to Budapest Airport for our flight back to Los Angeles via Amsterdam, bringing home wonderful memories of our unforgettable journey through the heart of Central Europe.
